The Tamar Odyssey is a catamaran giving a comfortable ride on lounge style seating. The layout is open-plan and guests are able to move between the outer, upper and lower decks including sitting with the Skipper in the spacious wheelhouse. All weather; fully heated in winter - cool in summer, the Tamar Odyssey has recently undergone a refurbishment, giving the vessel a crisp new look.

The Lady Launceston has been purpose built to cruise the Cataract Gorge. The design is reminiscent of the 1890s with sweeping traditional lines, the environmentally friendly vessel is custom designed with a unique silent hybrid/electric drive, allowing a serene glide into the Cataract Gorge and overhead 360 degrees viewing. Comfortable open planned seating ensures guests are free to move around. Fully heated in winter – cool and breezy in the summer; ensures all passengers cruise in maximum comfort.

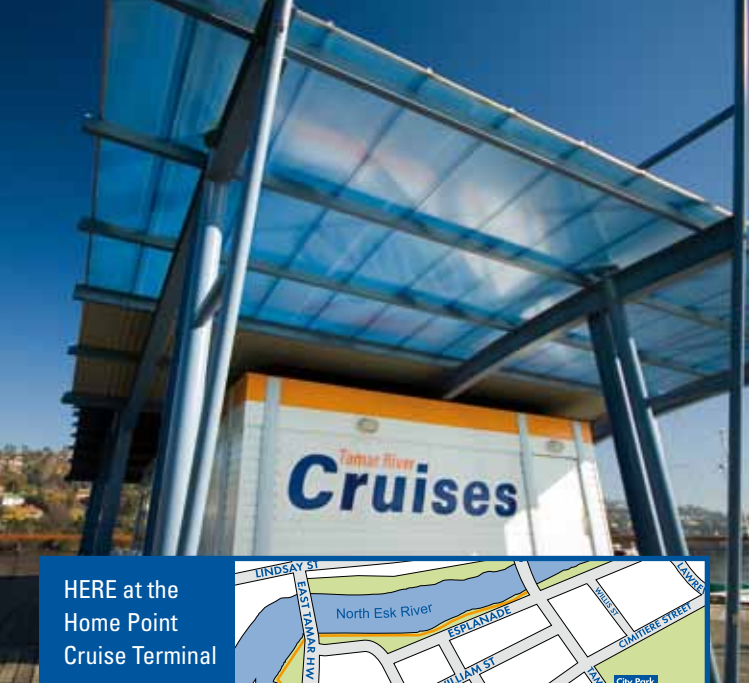

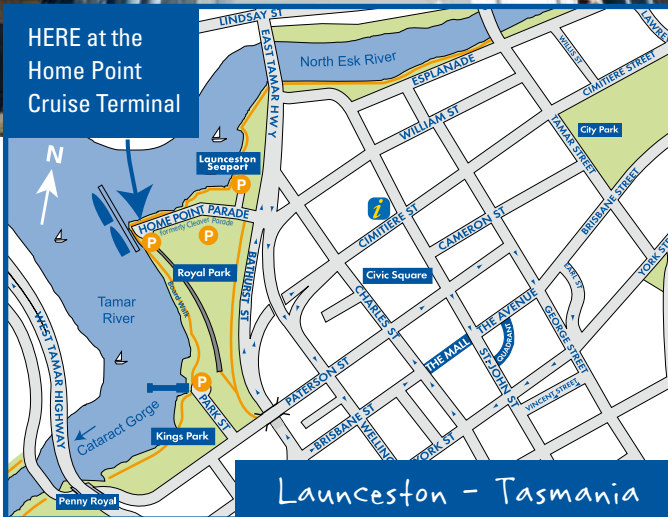
